Bill Description

This bill creates legislation that requires the board to provide public and private peace officer data to a prosecuting authority for purposes of complying with constitutional obligation to disclose evidence to a criminal defendant.

Assumptions

The POST Board will be required to respond to data requests from prosecuting authorities for public and non-public data with little to no impact the POST Board’s operations or regulatory authority. Public data is already available to prosecuting authorities via an online public portal reducing the amount of data that the board will have to provide to authorized authorities.
