## **Bill Description**

This bill aims to prohibit the download of the TikTok application or use the TikTok website on state telecommunications devices accessible by or issued to a state employe or contractor for official business.

#### **Assumptions**

- 1. The cost estimate pertains to devices under the management of MNIT, primarily for use by state employees or contractors of consolidated agencies within the executive branch.
- 2. Devices owned by agencies but not managed by MNIT, as well as personal devices of employees or contractors, fall outside the purview of this solution and are not included in MNIT's implementation of this bill.
- 3. The term "devices" encompasses laptops, desktops, and mobile devices, which include smartphones and tablets.
- 4. The cost estimate factors in a 5% inflationary increase for fiscal years 2026 and 2027.
- 5. Effective date is assumed to be July 1, 2024.
- 6. New funding will be appropriated for the implementation of this bill since existing funding is not available.

## **Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula**

MNIT's enforcement capacity is limited to state devices under its management, which comprise laptops, desktops, and mobile devices such as smartphones and tablets. Devices that are owned by agencies but not managed by MNIT, as well as personal devices of employees, are not included in this solution and fall outside the scope of MNIT's implementation of this statute.

At present, MNIT has the technology to prevent the installation of the TikTok application on state-managed mobile devices and to block access to the TikTok website from state laptops/desktops. However, additional software will need to be procured to restrict web access to TikTok from mobile devices. The cost associated with implementing this capability is detailed below.
