Bill Description

This bill draft would require the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities system to implement a credit transfer process through which at least 30 credits that a student earns toward a bachelor's degree at any public four-year institution in the state are transferable to a Minnesota State community college for credit toward an associate's degree.

The transfer process must be in place by July 2021.

Assumptions

Within the Minnesota State system, students are currently able transfer credits from a four-year institution to a two-year institution. This bill draft would require the system to establish a program by which credits from any public four-year institution outside of Minnesota State could be transferred to a two-year institution within the Minnesota State system.

In order to add this process, a contract would need to be entered into with the National Clearinghouse. Initial Subscriptions to two tools, Transcript Importer and Batch, would need to purchased. Each transfer completed would also require staff time to process, but this could be accomplished by existing staff.

Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

Transcript Importer and Batch tool costs:

\$205,000 one-time license fee for Transcript Importer and Batch (cost in first year only) \$180,000 annual subscription fees for both licenses (cost in first year and in following years) \$385,000 total (total cost in first year)

Long-Term Fiscal Considerations

Costs for the two software subscriptions would be ongoing expenses. The cost of software subscriptions tends to increase significantly over time.
